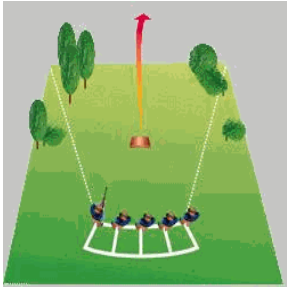

- NO GLASS containers on the river
- No previous kayak experience is necessary but you should be comfortable around water.
